FEE STRUCTURE - 2021

Certification verification is decided by the (NAB) National Admissions Board and not the NHICC.

Note that a 1X initial application fee applies to your 1st year. Annual Maintenance Renewals are set at \$150.

National Exam Fee \$100.00 (Online & includes NHICC proctor)

- **Non-NHICC application (Fee based \$75.00 proctor + \$100.00 exam fee)** *Includes NHICC Exam proctor
- Must be completed by ALL applicants from British Columbia and Alberta
- Applies to ALL other NEW applications other than ACI & RHI transfers
- The NHICC – NAB will accept recognized equivalencies with valid documentation (E.g. – NHIE)

TIPR¹ \$400.00 (Except for BC – It must be performed by an approved licensed BC inspector)

TIPR² \$200.00 (Alternate in case where limitations place a burden on delivery due to extenuating circumstances)

ACI, RHI – Straight Transfer Total³ - Requires current documentation³ for verification

The on-site practical home inspection test (TIPR) may be taken after formal background review and placement by the National Admissions Board. Rescheduling a TIPR without appropriate (7 day prior) notice = \$200.00 cancellation fee. The candidate must successfully complete the NHICC National Exam to be eligible for a TIPR or where the National Admissions Board has recommended the individual for a TIPR. The TIPR must be completed SUCCESSFULLY before an individual can achieve the NHI “designation”.

Annual Maintenance (Renewal) Fee: as specified for returning registrants to maintain your certificate status and report continuing education and/or E&O coverage where mandated.

NOTE: ALL APPLICATIONS MUST PROVIDE VALID DOCUMENTATION TO PROCEED AND AVOID DELAYS

FYI: Did you know the average price for membership in a home inspection association in Canada is approximately \$500+ per year? Did you know the NHICC is a true Not-for-profit Corporation and not a home inspection association? We are strictly about “certification” within the home inspection sector.

If you compare that over a 5 year period with the NHICC there's a significant cost savings. The difference of 5x\$500 = \$2500 versus the initial first year at \$650 max. + (4 renewals x \$150) = \$1250 with the NHICC. That's a cost saving of 50%. It may be less if you defer your TIPR or exam.
